Abstract submission instruction

- Please submit your abstract for scientific review by email to abstract.tshg2023@gmail.com
- Abstracts will be accepted until Friday, 5th May 2023: Midnight.
- Your abstract should follow the template below and be saved as an MS word file.
- Your abstract should not exceed 300 words and include no more than 2 figures/tables.

Abstract template

Title should be concise and informative (*Time New Roman 12 points/bold/ left-justified*)

Abstract (*Time New Roman 12 points/left-justified, maximum 300 words*)

Background Provide a brief introduction to the research question and rationale

Methods Describe the study design, participants, interventions, outcomes, and statistical analysis

Results Report the main findings of the study with appropriate measures of effect size and uncertainty

Conclusions Summarize the main implications and limitations of the study

Acknowledgements

Keywords 3-5 keywords that describe your study topic

Abstract Presentation Rules

- All abstracts will be considered for poster presentation by default
- The scientific committee may select up to three abstracts for oral communication based on their quality and relevance
- If your abstract is chosen for oral communication, you will be required to give a live presentation at TSHG2023 on 30th May 2023 from 11:25 am-12:25 pm. You will have 20 minutes in total, including questions; so please plan to speak for no more than 12 minutes.
- If your abstract is accepted for poster presentation, you will need to prepare and display your poster according to the poster presentation guideline and attend the poster session at TSHG2023.

Poster Presentation Guideline

- Your poster will be presented as an onsite e-poster.
- Please prepare your poster file according to the poster presentation guideline and email the final PDF file to abstract.tshg2023@gmail.com by Friday, 5th May 2023: Midnight.
- You must register and attend the onsite conference to present your poster.
- Your poster will be accessible to all conference attendees for both days.

- Your poster must have a portrait orientation and fit within an A0 size (80cm x 120cm).
- Your poster must be written in English only.
- Poster sections include: -
 - Title (with names of authors and affiliations)
 - Introduction/Objectives/Aims/Problem/Goal
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
 - References
 - Acknowledgements
 - Contact information (including QR code), if available
- Your poster should be clear and concise so that it can be understood without your explanation. You can add more details and discussion points during the poster session.
- Your poster should use appropriate fonts and colors:
 - Titles should be readable from 10-15 feet away
 - Captions should be visible from 4 feet away
 - The text should be aligned to the left
 - You can use italics or bold for emphasis, but avoid underlining or using all caps
 - You should use dark text on a light background for better contrast
